She cuts strips of cloth about 2 " wide and attaches each strip to the next by making a specific join that is invisible. This particular loom creates throw rugs, which she has throughout her home.

On another day, she brought a smaller loom, which she uses to make place mats. For this particular place mat, she cut the strips from an old blanket that makes the place mat very washable and durable.

The group enjoyed seeing a different craft. Our group meets each Monday from noon to three. Come according to your own schedule. If Monday is a holiday, we'll meet on Wednesday of that week.




